

Construction of New Urology Centre – Notice of Road Closure

24th April 2017 – Summer 2018

From Monday 24th April 2017 the road from the HASTE Wing to the West Wing entrance (alongside the disabled bays and around the bend) will be closed until the Summer of 2018. This is to enable the new state of the art Urology Centre to be built.

The diversion route will be signed from the fork in the road adjacent to the HASTE Wing out on to Gill Avenue and then through the Surrey Research Park to access the hospital from Stirling Avenue. The Research Park gates will be left open so that access to this area will be available 24/7. We apologise for any inconvenience caused. Please follow diversion signs shown below. The main areas which will be affected by the diversion are as follows:

- The Nuffield Hospital
- Disabled parking spaces
- Staff parking spaces (opposite the Nuffield Hospital)
- Ambulance car parking spaces
- West Wing entrance pick up/drop offs
- Occupational Therapy equipment store pick up/drop offs
- Education Centre deliveries
- St Luke's Level B pick up/drop offs
- Radiation Protection loading/unloading spaces
